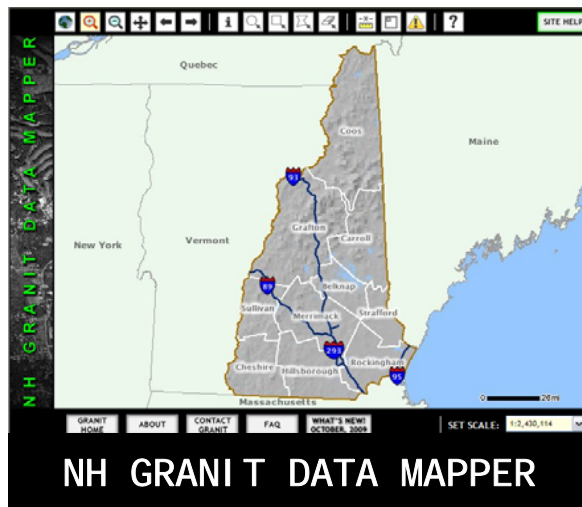

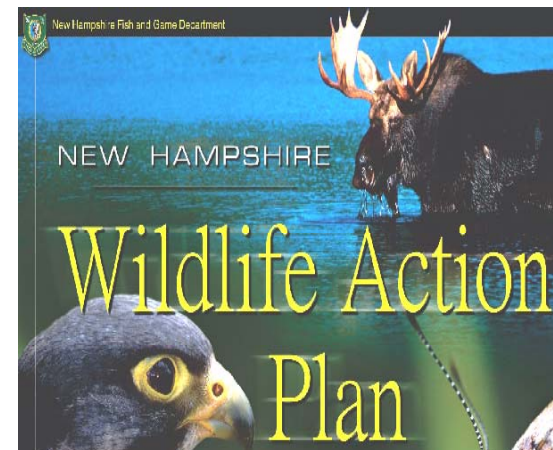


Directions to The Conservation Center

54 Portsmouth St., Concord, NH 03301

From I-93, take Exit 16 toward RT-132/E. Concord. Turn east onto W. Portsmouth St. Turn slight right onto NH-132/East Side Dr. and travel 0.8 mile. Turn right onto Portsmouth St. After 0.3 mile, the Conservation Center is on the left.

From I-393, take Exit 2. Turn right onto East Side Drive and travel about one mile, where you will see a brown and white Conservation Center sign. Turn left onto Portsmouth St. After 0.3 mile, the Conservation Center is on the left.

Workshop Description

NHDES permit applications for wetlands, timber harvest, shoreland, alteration of terrain, and federal checklists all require access to data and maps that are available through state and federal agencies. This one-day workshop will cover **what is out there, where to get it, and what to do with it**. Agencies will explain how their data is generated and maintained, and how applicants can access the information. There will be demonstrations of the NH Data Mapper web tool, and a presentation of software and technology available for more advanced analysis. Handouts and web links will be provided.
