The Common Man Restaurant in Concord, NH is located just off I-93 Exit 13. From the north, turn right. From the south, turn left.

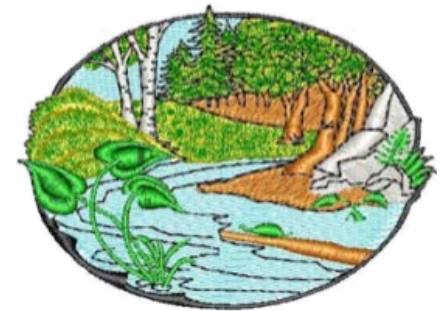

**Trout Unlimited's Program for
 Stream Assessment and
 Restoration in New Hampshire**

Trout Unlimited (TU) has been very active across numerous New Hampshire watersheds, evaluating streams for existing habitat, identifying culvert barriers to aquatic connectivity and working with towns on infrastructure vulnerability and flood resiliency. Colin Lawson, New England Culvert Project Coordinator, Trout Unlimited, will outline TU's landscape scale approach, describe progress in specific watersheds and share lessons learned on critical instream restoration efforts. From bridge replacements to building large wood habitat, Colin will share TU's approach to developing community partnerships and accessing federal, state, and private conservation funding.

Presenter Bio

Colin joined Trout Unlimited (TU) in 2009 as the New England Culvert Project Coordinator (NECP). His focus is on reconnecting Eastern brook trout habitat in priority New England watersheds through the removal, replacement or retrofit of currently impassable road stream crossings and other instream barriers. Colin's graduate work in environmental science concentrated on hydroecology at Antioch New England University in Keene, NH. His thesis was on modeling the hydraulic capacity of stormwater infrastructure.
